
Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) is a power transmission system operator that delivers safe and cost-effective electric power across 15 U.S. states and the Canadian province of Manitoba. MISO operates one of the world's largest energy markets with more than \$29 billion in annual gross market energy transactions.

Project Overview

MISO was a long-time user of the Oracle Hyperion Planning platform, utilizing the tool for corporate budgeting and forecasting. As the organization's strategic and IT objectives evolved over time and offline processes grew more numerous, the Finance and Accounting teams looked to Oracle Cloud as an opportunity to modernize their platform and implement a cloud-based business-owned solution.

As the initial phase of a larger Finance Transformation program, MISO selected Oracle's EPM Cloud - Planning process as the first wave of their transition to the Oracle Cloud. MISO is building capabilities around Investment and Workforce Planning, in addition to more frequent and automated data loads, and more robust reporting and analysis.

Business Challenges



As a user of on-premise solutions for ERP (Oracle EBS) and EPM (Hyperion Planning), MISO embarked on a journey to the Cloud to drive business value and reduce support and maintenance costs. EPM Cloud became Phase 1 in an effort to see immediate gains in planning accuracy & to begin promoting user adoption with Oracle Cloud.

MISO's prior Planning solution also had several limitations which drove the evaluation:

- High support costs for an "end-of-life" version
- Limited drill down capabilities causing inability to identify key
 drivers
- Reliance on IT for data integration and automation

- Enhancements to the 36-month rolling forecast capabilities and ability to Long Range Plan
- Driver-based workforce solution seamlessly leverages details from ADP
